
## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- Cut the papers according to the cutting guides. Tip: Keep a pad of sticky notes and a pen handy to easily mark the identifying letter on each piece as they are cut. This will make assembling the layouts much easier!
- Cut the papers, gather the base pages and follow the instructions to assemble the layouts. Crop and add photos as shown on the layout guides. Journal onto the lighter papers or white cardstock. Apply stickers and embellishments using Foam Squares to add dimension.
- TIP: Further enhance your pages by punching shapes or borders from coordinating cardstock (Baby Blue, Blue, Dark Green, Beige or Hot Fudge) and adding them to your layout!

## **CUTTING GUIDE -**


Make the following cuts on designer paper.

1 Designer Paper #1 - Trees



Tip: Before cutting, check the direction of the papers so that the patterns are upright as shown in the layout guide!


2 Designer Paper #2 - Flowing Water




3 Designer Paper #3 - Brown Woodgrain



Tip: Reverse square 4E BEFORE cutting it in half to ensure the pattern is oriented in the desired direction. 4 Designer Paper #4 - Brown Woodgrain



**5** Designer Paper #5 - Green Trellis



## Two-Page Spread










#### **PROJECT #1 INSTRUCTIONS**

- Create the left base page by aligning pieces 1A, 1C and 3A in a row face down on work surface. Cut two strips from leftover or scrap paper, approximately 1" x 12". Apply the Tape Runner liberally along the strip and place over the seam between each piece to "weld" them together. Repeat with pieces 1B, 1D and 3B to form the right base page. Alternatively, arrange and adhere pieces directly onto two pieces of 12x12 White Solid Cardstock or White Refill Pages.
- Adhere photos to pieces 5A-5D before arranging and adhere the matted photos to the layout as shown.
- Trim the journal card insert from the Getting Outside Embellishment pack to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" and adhere to layout as shown.
- Add remaining photos and journal as desired.
   TIP: Ink can smear easily on the coated finish of the journal card insert, so take care and let ink dry completely!
- Optional: Add embellishments using Foam Squares to add dimension.

## One-Page Layout






## **PROJECT #2 INSTRUCTIONS**


- Use one sheet of blue designer paper for your base page.
- Use the Tape Runner to adhere piece 2C in the middle of the page.
- Adhere photos to pieces 4F-4I before arranging and adhering the matted photos to the layout as shown.
- Adhere both triangular halves of 4E in opposite corners as shown. Adhere pieces 4C and 4D over the long edges of each triangle before trimming off the overhanging paper with Micro-Tip Scissors.
- · Optional: Add embellishments using Foam Squares to add dimension and journal as desired.

## Two-Page Spread










### **PROJECT #3 INSTRUCTIONS**

- Use two sheets of Beige Solid Cardstock for your base pages.
- Assemble the two borders, the embellishment clusters and the title cluster from the Getting Outside Border & Title Kit, using Foam Squares if desired to add dimension.
- Use the Tape Runner to adhere the assembled borders across both base pages, approximately 1/4" up from the bottom edges.
- Adhere pieces 2A and 2B across the top edges of both base pages, followed by 4A and 4B directly below them as shown.
- Adhere remaining pieces 5E and 5F as shown.
- Adhere the title cluster above piece 5E, and the embellishment clusters on each border as shown.
- Add photos and journal as desired.
- Optional: Add additional embellishments using Foam Squares to add dimension.

### **BONUS PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS**

- Use one White Card or an  $8-1/2" \times 5-1/2"$  piece of White Solid Cardstock, scored and folded in half as a card base.
- Use the Tape Runner to adhere piece 5G in the middle of the card. Adhere piece 4J on top as shown.
- Adhere piece 2D 1-1/2" up from the bottom edge of the card base.
- Optional: Add embellishments using Foam Squares to add dimension.
