

Gnome Card Designs

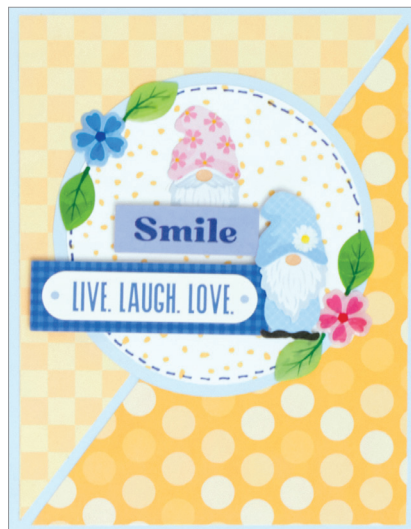
GENERAL INGREDIENTS

- White Solid Cardstock
- 12-inch Trimmer with Straight and Scoring Blades
- 13x13 Custom Cutting System Mat
- Circle Custom Cutting System Patterns with Red and Green Blades
- Tape Runner
- Foam Squares Variety Pack
- Navy Dual-Tip Pen

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- For each card, use the 12-inch Trimmer to cut a 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle from White Solid Cardstock.
- Turn the rectangle so the 8-1/2" side is at the top of the trimmer. Change the Straight Blade to the Scoring Blade and score at 4-1/4". Remove the card from the trimmer and fold in half along scored line to create the card base.

CARD #1



INGREDIENTS

- Welcome Spring Gnome Embellishments
- Totally Tonal Canary Paper Pack
- Totally Tonal Baby Blue Stickers
- Baby Blue Solid Cardstock

INSTRUCTIONS

- Use the 12-inch Trimmer to cut a 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece of Baby Blue Cardstock and adhere it to the front of the card with the Tape Runner.
- Cut a 4" x 5-1/4" piece of checkered paper. Then cut on a diagonal from the top-right corner to the bottom-left corner to create a triangle. Adhere the triangle to the top-left of the card, leaving about an 1/8" space from the edges of the card. Repeat with a piece of large dots paper and adhere the triangle to the bottom-right of the card.
- Use the inside of the largest Circle Custom Cutting System Pattern and the Red Blade to cut a circle from Baby Blue Cardstock. Use the Green Blade on the inside edge to cut a circle from scattered speckles paper. Layer and adhere the pieces together, then adhere to the card as shown.
- Use a Navy Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitching around the scattered speckles circle.
- Adhere title stickers and embellishments with Foam Squares. Add enamel stickers as shown.

CARD #2



INGREDIENTS

- Welcome Summer Gnome Embellishments
- Tropic Time Paper Pack
- Tropic Time Embellishments

INSTRUCTIONS

- Use the 12-inch Trimmer to cut a 4" x 5-1/4" piece of dotted paper. Then cut on a diagonal from the top-left corner to the bottom-right corner to create a triangle. Adhere the triangle to the top-right of the card, leaving about an 1/8" space from the edges of the card. Repeat with a piece of flower suns paper and adhere the triangle to the bottom-left of the card.
- Use the inside of the largest Circle Custom Cutting System Pattern and the Red Blade to cut a circle from White Cardstock. Use the Green Blade on the inside edge to cut a circle from sun tiles paper. Layer and adhere the pieces together, then adhere to the card as shown.
- Use a Navy Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitching around the sun tiles circle.
- Adhere a title embellishment and gnome embellishments with Foam Squares. Add enamel stickers as shown.

CARD #3



INGREDIENTS

- Welcome Autumn Gnome Embellishments
- Autumn Harvest Paper Pack
- Autumn Harvest Stickers
- Cranberry Solid Cardstock

INSTRUCTIONS

- Use the 12-inch Trimmer to cut a 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece of Cranberry Cardstock and adhere it to the front of the card with the Tape Runner.
- Cut a 4" x 5-1/4" piece of juniper leaves paper. Then cut on a diagonal from the top-left corner to the bottom-right corner to create a triangle. Adhere the triangle to the top-right of the card, leaving about an 1/8" space from the edges of the card. Repeat with a piece of plaid paper and adhere the triangle to the bottom-left of the card.
- Use the inside of the largest Circle Custom Cutting System Pattern and the Red Blade to cut a circle from Cranberry Cardstock. Use the Green Blade on the inside edge to cut a circle from maple leaves paper. Layer and adhere the pieces together, then adhere to the card as shown.
- Use a Navy Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitching around the maple leaves circle.
- Adhere stickers and embellishments with Foam Squares. Add enamel stickers as shown.

CARD #4



INGREDIENTS

- Welcome Winter Gnome Embellishments
- Nordic Winter Paper Pack
- Nordic Winter Stickers
- Navy Solid Cardstock

INSTRUCTIONS

- Use the 12-inch Trimmer to cut a 4-1/4" x 5-1/2" piece of Navy Cardstock and adhere it to the front of the card with the Tape Runner.
- Cut a 4" x 5-1/4" piece of pinwheel quilt paper. Then cut on a diagonal from the top-left corner to the bottom-right corner to create a triangle. Adhere the triangle to the top-right of the card, leaving about an 1/8" space from the edges of the card. Repeat with a piece of folk floral paper and adhere the triangle to the bottom-left of the card.
- Use the inside of the largest Circle Custom Cutting System Pattern and the Red Blade to cut a circle from Navy Cardstock. Use the Green Blade on the inside edge to cut a circle from woodgrain paper. Layer and adhere the pieces together, then adhere to the card as shown.
- Use a Navy Dual-Tip Pen to add faux stitching around the woodgrain circle.
- Adhere stickers and embellishments with Foam Squares. Add enamel stickers as shown.
