## Card Fast Formula

Make five cards quickly and easily with minimal supplies! Can be adapted to suit ANY theme by using different paper packs and embellishments. Repeat the cutting guide with different papers to create 15 cards - great for when you need to add to your card stash!

## CUTTING GUIDE:



- Square pieces D-I and T: 1-3/4" $\times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
- Circle pieces J-L and U: 1-3/4" circle


## SUPPLIES

- Two $6^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ pieces of designer paper of your choice
- Five White Cards \& Envelopes
- 12-inch Trimmer
- Square Punch
- Circle Punch (or use CCS Circle Patterns and Blades)
- Tape Runner
- Foam Squares
- Dual-Tip Pen


## CUTTING GUIDE INSTRUCTIONS

- Note: All the pieces to make the five cards shown CAN be cut from one piece of $12^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ paper, but to increase the pattern and color options and to add interest and variety, we recommend using two $6^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ pieces of different double-sided designer paper so you have four pattern/color options to choose from when assembling your cards.
- Cut or punch all shapes from paper as shown. (Tip: If you are cutting additional papers to make 15 cards, group all similar pieces together in piles to make card assembly easier!)
- Lay cards on work surface and distribute pieces between them, choosing which patterns and colors to combine on each card.
- Adhere paper pieces with the Tape Runner.
- Apply stickers or embellishments using Foam Squares to add dimension.
- Journal as desired with a Dual-Tip Pen.


## BONUS IDEAS

- Each card design can be used as a vertical or horizontal design based on what works best for the sentiment or embellishments you are using.
- Papers with small scale or tone-on-tone patterns show up best on small pieces. Choose paper with high contrast between designs on front and back for the most options.
- Cardstock and Shimmer papers can also be used with beautiful results.
- Most individual pieces are small enough to be cut from scraps as well.
- Try mirroring or rotating the card designs for even more options!
- Adhere a $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of paper before any of the cut shapes if you prefer not to see the white card base.
